

Appendix A – Development Impact Fees Schedules

- 1. Development impact fees are assessed in accordance with the Fee Schedules incorporated with Ordinance 11203 as adopted by the Mayor and Council on October 9, 2014.
 - a. For the residential land use categories (single-family residential, condo/townhomes, multi-family residential/apartments), fees shown are per residential unit. For the non-residential land use categories (retail, office, industrial), fees shown are per 1000 square feet of building area.
 - b. The tables do not include an administrative fee.
- 2. For the period from December 23, 2014 through and including June 30, 2016, development impact fees shall be assessed and paid at the "phase-in fee" rates represented in Table 1, of Section 23A-91. The Phase-In fee rates were extended on multiple occasions by the Mayor and Council. The Full Adopted fee rates described in Table 2 were never implemented by the Mayor and Council. Instead, they were replaced by a new fee schedule put into place beginning August 23, 2020.
