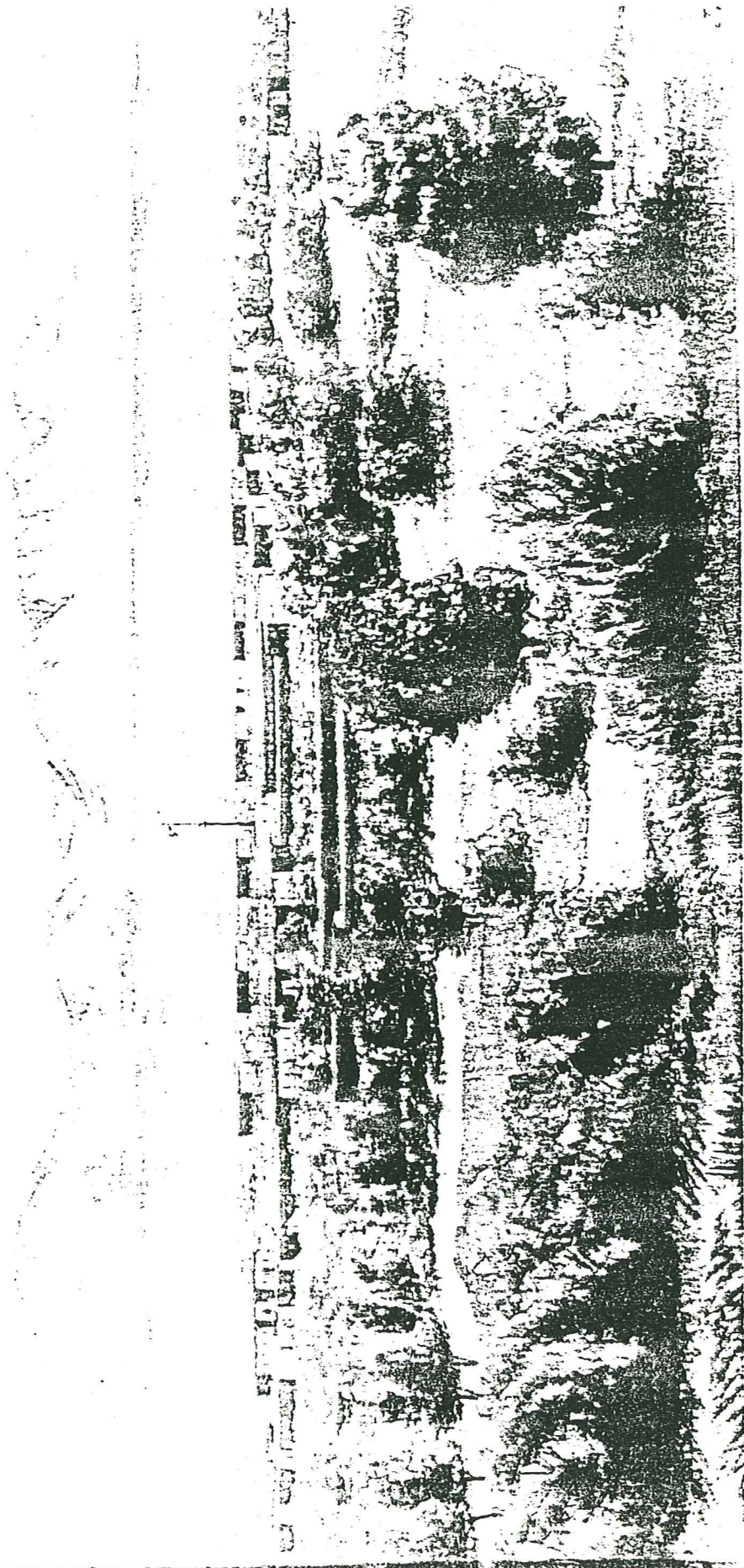

Row Lane 1888



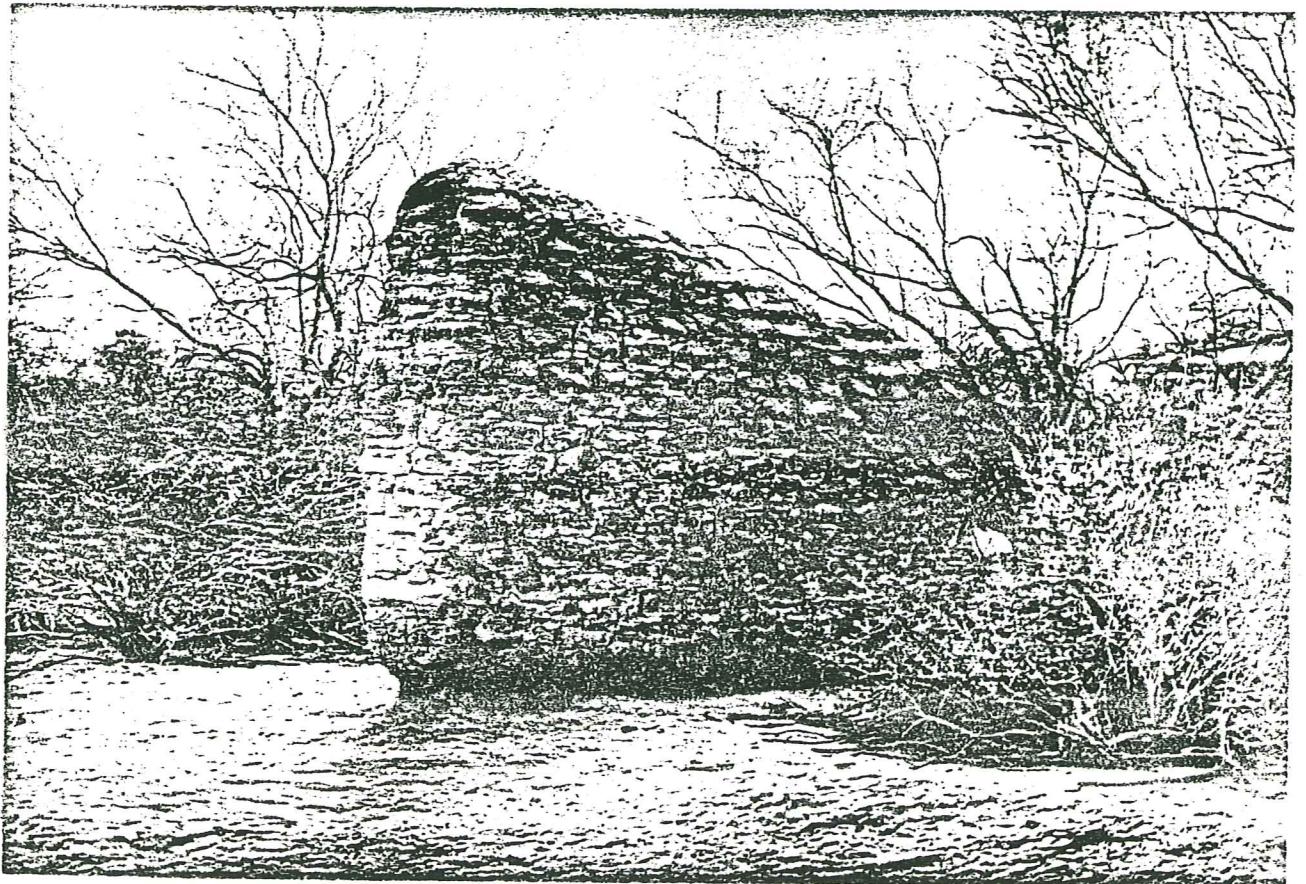
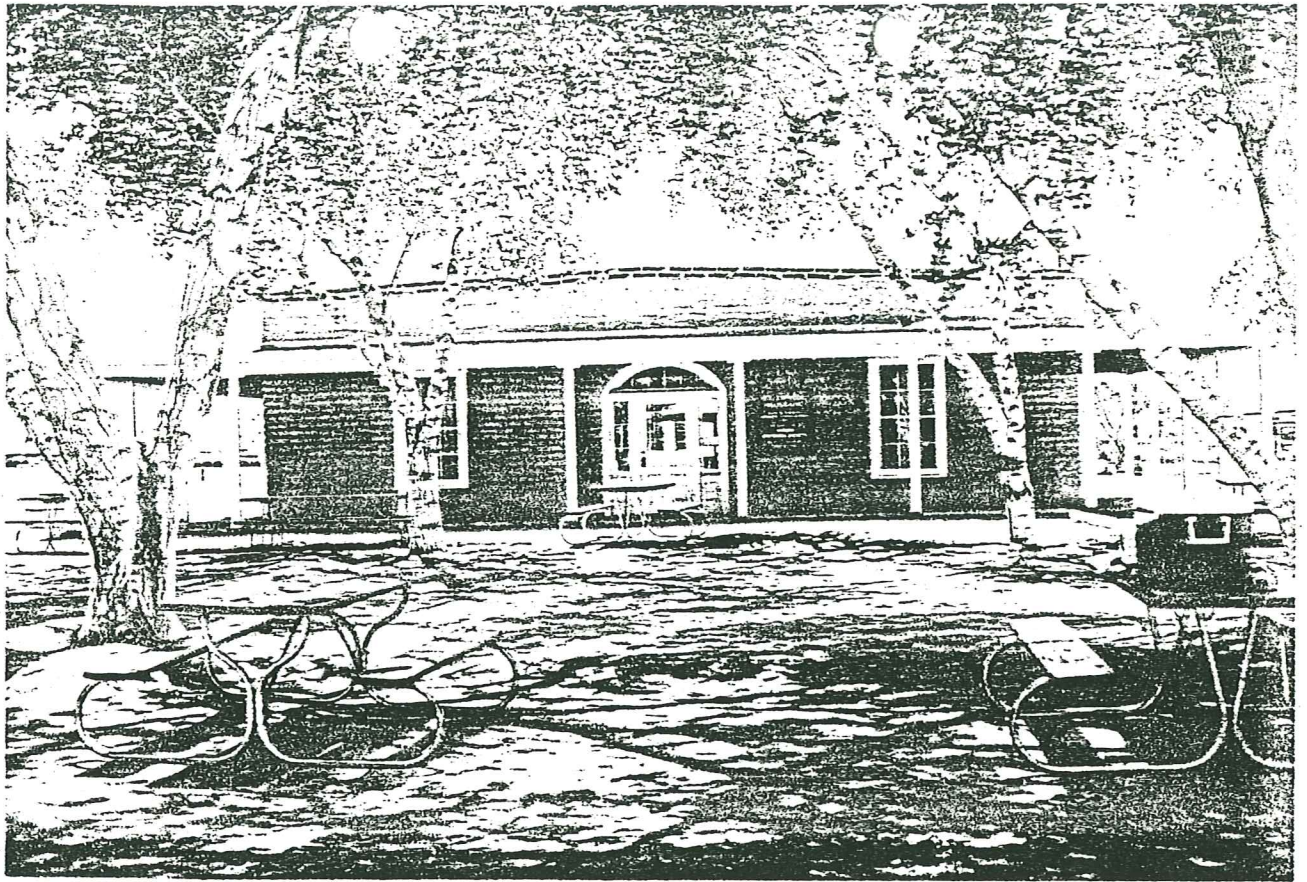

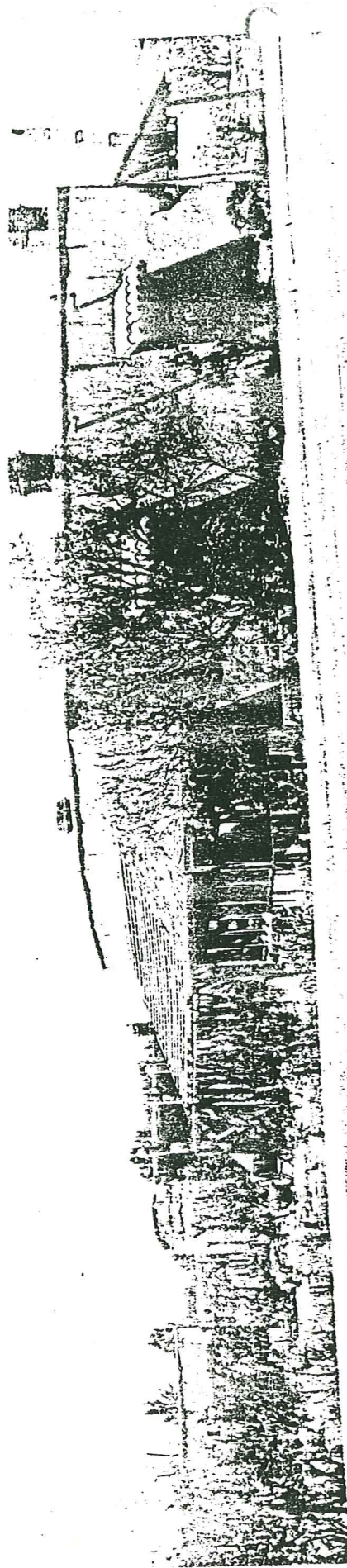


Officers quarters looking northwest from Craycroft

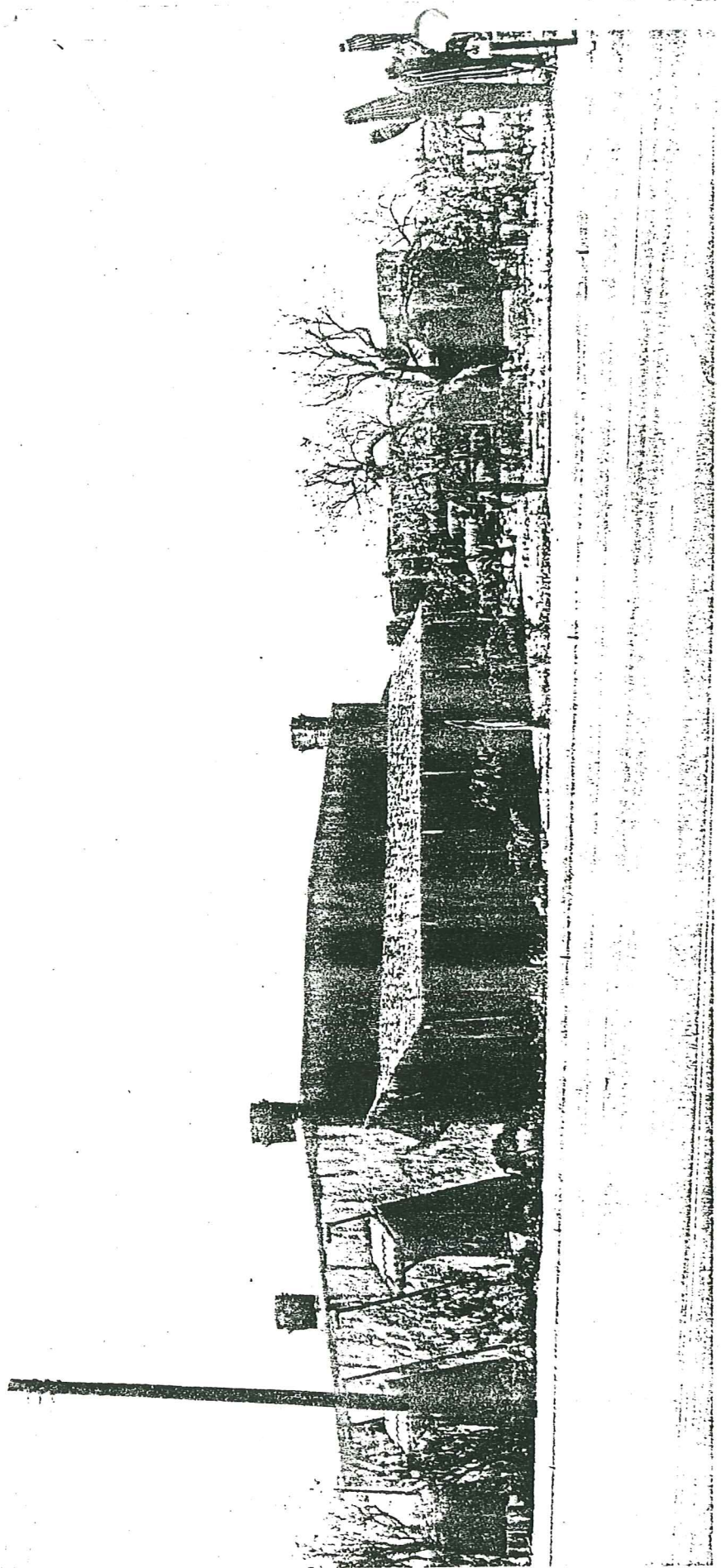


Officers' quarters, looking southwest from Craycroft

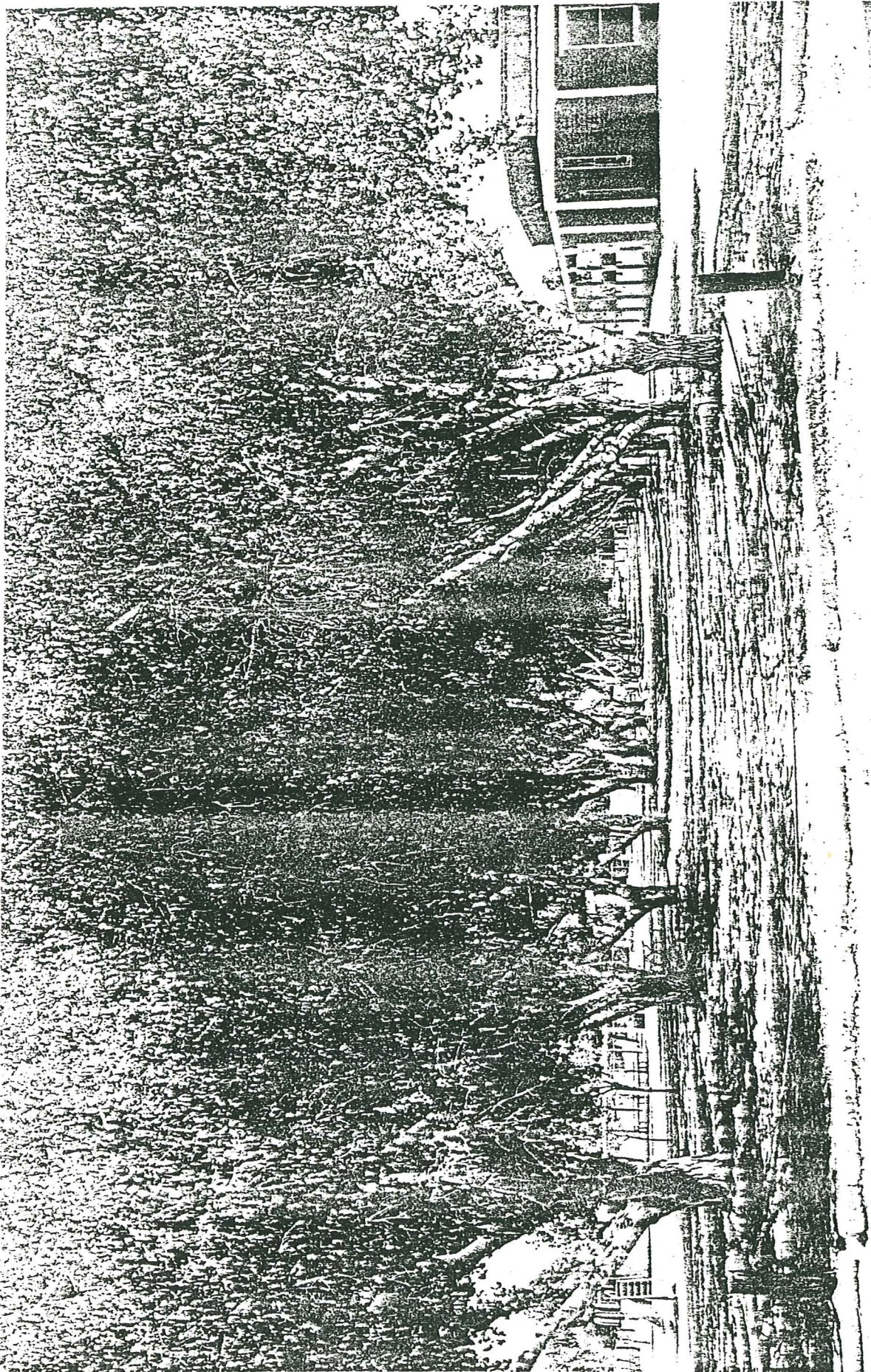


Cottonwood Lane in Front Lowell Park (Looking east)

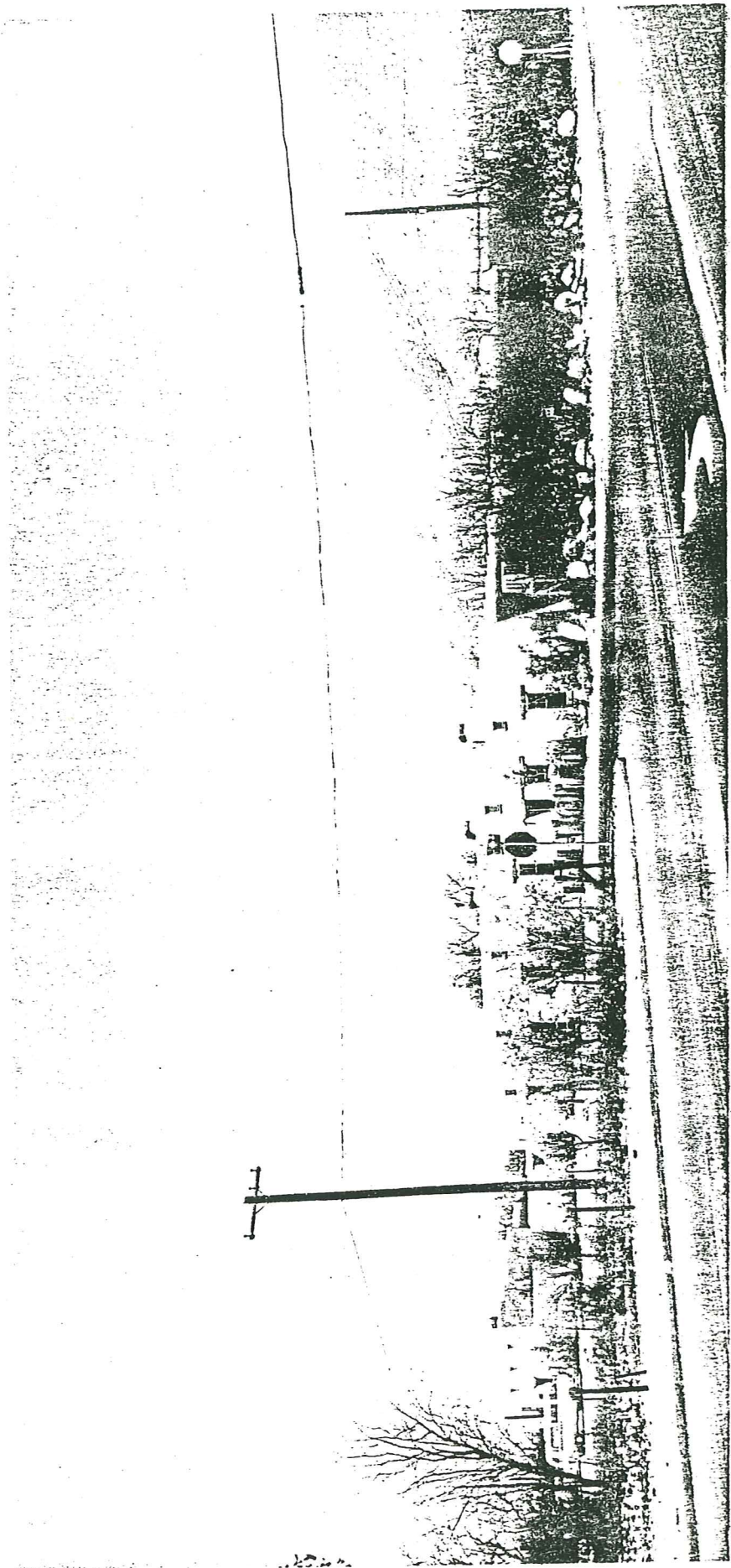


Corner of Craycroft and Ft. Lowell Rd., looking northwest

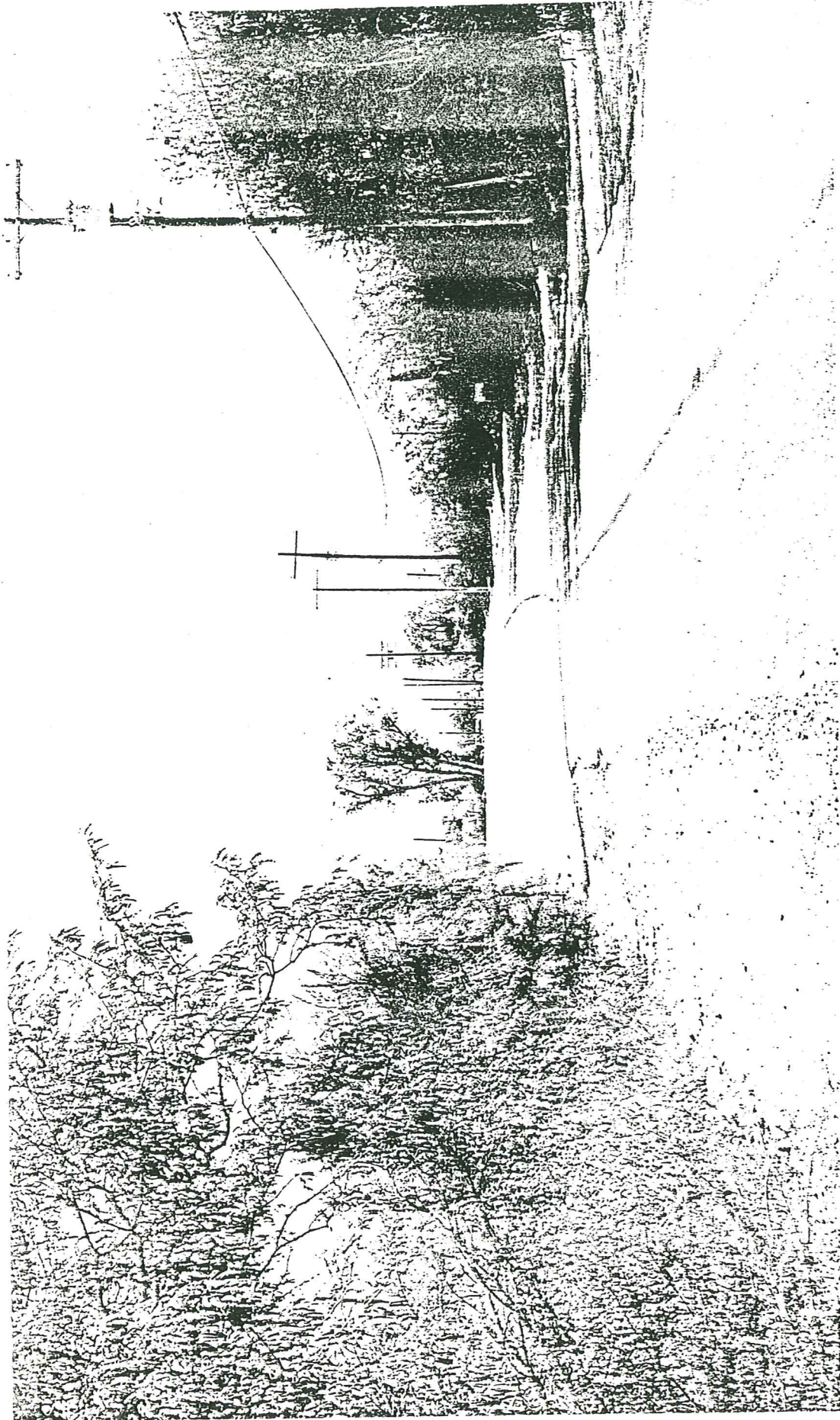

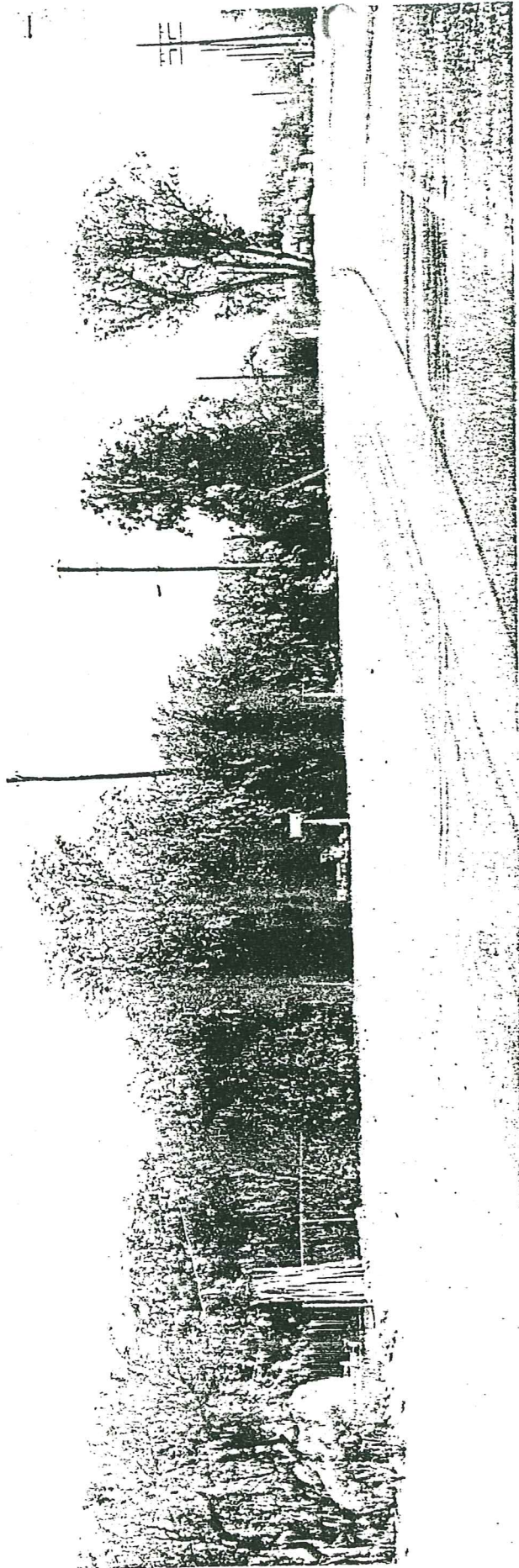
