
The Blixt/Avitia House at 830 W. Alameda Street, Tucson, Pima County, Arizona, was individually listed in the National Register of Historic Places on March 30, 1992.

Information provided by Allison Diehl, acting historic preservation officer for the City of Yuma, indicated the property in 2017 had undergone a severe rehabilitation resulting in the loss of all historic stylistic characteristics that had made it significant in the area of architecture. The following photos indicate the extent of the alterations.


2016 photograph of Blixt/Avitia House prior to major exterior rehabilitation. Source: Google.


