



How to Read the Election Summary Report

There are three columns of information (Total Votes, Vote by Mail [VBM], and Provisional) for each elected office, arranged by Political Party in the following order: Democratic (DEM), Republican (REP), and Libertarian (LBT).

Definition of Terms used:

Registered Voters: The number of voters eligible to vote in the City of Tucson **2015 Primary Election:**

- 1. You must have resided in the City of Tucson since July 26, and
- 2. You must be registered to vote on or before July 27, and
- 3. You must be at least 18 years old on August 25.

Precincts Counted: The total number of precincts in either the jurisdiction or Ward.

Registered Voters: The total number of registered voters within the City of Tucson then broken down by party.

Ballots Cast: Number of ballots counted citywide as of the date and time of this report, then broken down by party.

Ballots Cast Nonpartisan: This does not apply to City of Tucson Elections. The city conducts partisan elections.

Ballots Cast Blank: Number of votes that were cast where the voter left the ballot blank.

Voter Turnout: The percentage of votes cast compared to registered voters.

Total Votes: The number of all votes cast.

VBM: Votes tabulated as Vote by Mail results.

PROV: Ballots held back until voting records have been checked for validity (i.e. address, party and name changes) and calculated at a later time.

Candidate: Total votes so far, per specified candidate. The percentage column indicates the percent of registered voters casting a vote for this candidate.

Write-In Votes: Total votes cast for a write-in candidate. These votes are only valid if there is an Official Write-In Candidate.

Over Voted: Number of votes cast for more than one candidate in the race.

Under Votes: Number of blank votes cast for a candidate.
