HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

100 BLOCK OF WEST KENTUCKY STREET

May 2, 2022 – Officers from Operations Division South were dispatched to a home in the 100 block of W. Kentucky St. for a report of a shooting. Officers arrived at approximately 2:00 a.m. and located an adult female in the home with gunshot trauma. Officers immediately began rendering aid until Tucson Fire Department personnel arrived. Despite lifesaving efforts, the victim succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Officers identified the victim as 40-year-old **Alma Daniela Gomez**. Next of kin was notified.

Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit were notified and responded to continue the investigation. Detectives served a search warrant on the home and processed the scene. Investigators are in the course of locating and interviewing witnesses to the incident. There are no suspects in custody; however, initial details suggest that the shooting was not a random act. As the investigation continues, detectives are asking anyone with information to come forward and call 88-CRIME. You can remain anonymous. Additional updates will be provided as they become available.
