HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION NORTH PARK AVENUE AND EAST SECOND STREET

UPDATE - APRIL 28, 2022

As the investigation has progressed, TPD Homicide Detectives have identified the shooting suspect and obtained a warrant for his arrest. Investigators have identified the suspect as 23-year-old **Trevontea Tyron Howard-Brown.** The warrant – for 1st Degree Murder and Attempted 1st Degree Murder – is active and at this point, detectives have exhausted all leads in locating him. Anyone with information regarding his whereabouts is urged to call 9-1-1 or 88-CRIME – should you wish to remain anonymous. He is described as 5'8, 145lbs. with medium length dreadlocks (colored tips), and is possibly wearing prescription glasses. Additionally, Howard-Brown has tattoos covering his neck and arms. **Trevontea should be considered armed and dangerous**. If he is located, <u>do not</u> approach him and call 9-1-1 immediately. Updates will be provided as they become available.

Early this morning, just after 2:00 a.m., a Tucson Police Officer was flagged down near N. Park Ave. and E. 2nd Street. in regards to a shooting in the area. As the officer responded and requested assistance, the Public Safety Communications Department (PSCD) began receiving several 9-1-1 calls reporting the shooting. Once on scene, officers were given a suspect description and an area search was initiated. The TPD Air Unit and K9 Units also responded to assist in the search; however, a suspect was not located.

Responding officers at the scene had located an adult male with gunshot trauma and immediately began rendering aid. Additionally, a second gunshot victim was located nearby with serious injuries. Upon arrival, Tucson Fire Department personnel pronounced the first victim deceased at the scene. Officers have identified that victim as 24-year-old **Harrison Weber**. The second victim, identified as a 21-year-old male, was transported to a local hospital in life-threatening condition but was later upgraded to stable condition. No other injuries were reported at the scene. Patrol officers had contacted several witnesses at the scene and called for detectives from the Homicide Unit to continue the investigation.

From initial interviews in conjunction with evidence recovered at the scene, detectives believe that two groups of individuals were involved in a confrontation which led to the shooting. Detectives are in the process of examining forensic evidence and conducting additional interviews in hopes of identifying the suspect and a motive. As detectives continue their investigation, they are urging anyone with information to come forward and call 9-1-1 or 88-CRIME, if they wish to remain anonymous. Additional updates will be provided as they become available.
