## I. PURPOSE

To align Tucson City Court non-juridical days with the non-juridical days or other closures of the Pima County Superior Court and courts within the Pima County.

## II. <u>POLICY</u>

- A. The Tucson City Court will coordinate and if appropriate align non-juridical days with those non-juridical or other closures of the Pima County Superior Court and courts within Pima County.
- B. A non-juridical day is a day when the court does not sit nor is open to the public to conduct business. Court employees are required to be at work or on approved time off.

## III. IMPLEMENTING INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Consistent with Pima County Superior Court Administrative Order No. 2013-32 (Amended), Superior Court Holiday Schedule, the Tucson City Court has established the fourth Friday after the fourth Thursday of November (Friday after Thanksgiving) as a non-juridical day replacing the second Monday of October (Columbus Day) as a non-juridical day. The second Monday of October (Columbus Day) will be a juridical day in the future.
- B. Court Managers are to develop internal departmental procedures consistent with this Court Administrative Order.

**REVIEW RESPONSIBILITY:** The Presiding Magistrate or designee will review this Court Administrative Order for revision or deletion biennially or as needed.
