FIREARMS SURRENDER INSTRUCTIONS

Those persons ordered by the Court to surrender firearms are required to relinquish their firearms by the following method:

- Turn your firearm(s) in to the Tucson Police Department
- This must be done within 24 hours of your notice to surrender
- Appear at Tucson Police Main Station on 270 S. Stone Avenue
- All firearms must be unloaded
- A Tucson Police officer will provide you with a receipt
- The firearm(s) will remain with the Tucson Police station until an order by the Court is issued releasing the firearm.

If you are found guilty of a domestic violence crime and you are sentenced to probation, you will become a prohibited possessor during the term of your probation. Your firearms will remain with the Tucson Police Station for the course of your probation.

A background check will be completed prior to the release of any firearm(s), even voluntary surrenders. Because Federal, State and local laws prohibit certain persons from possessing firearms, it is possible that the firearm(s) may not be returned.
