






Proposition 409 – Major Streets

> 830 Lane Miles






Proposition 409 – Local Streets






Tucson Delivers – Local Streets

Selection Process

- Oversight Commission
- Discussions & Recommendations
 - ✓ By Grid
 - ✓ Overall Condition Index (OCI)*
 - ✓ Treatment Strategy
 - ✓ Community Input
 - * OCI is a numerical index, ranging from 0 for a failed pavement to 100 for a pavement in excellent condition. Calculation of OCI is based on the results of a visual condition survey.
