4. Discussion of Commission Goals and Priorities

Presentation by Jay Young on the future goals of the Commission and what are the future goals and priorities over the next couple of years. Refocusing on what our vision is and what we are trying to accomplish, and the impossible action on requesting a commission consultant.

Focusing on someone local that knows Tucson and our goals to facilitate a conversation to get us to the next step in the Commission's goals and implementing that was approved by the Mayor and Council.

Other topics of discussion was focusing on an Equitable Tucson and how we as a Commission can get there and having a community voice be a part of the meeting. Jay Young will bring to the next meeting the results of the study done by ASU students on Equity. Study available on Commissioners website.

Presenting for HCD Ernesto Portillo discussing adding an ex-officio seat for public housing or a housing Choice voucher representative. To make a formal recommendation to the Mayor and Council.

Mindy Bernstein made a motion to add Ex-officio member. on the Commission for an Individual who is reciting or participating in the continuum of the city supported within Public Housing or using Housing Choice Voucher. Vicki Cuscino seconded the motion. -A vote of 8-0 was passed.

7. Subcommittee Updates

A. Housing First

B. Housing Segregation

-Discussion held; Focus and Vision on Equity Study and what housing equity is and a goal to get there, also, what Desegregation in Tucson is and recognizing all parts of that meaning.

8. HCD Updates

-Presenting for HCD was Ernesto Portillo, explained that Director Liz Morales and Deputy Director Ann Chanecka were preparing for HUD officials; HCD is a finalist for the 50-million-dollar transformation grant, focusing on the Tucson House and the immediate area. Grant will be announced in Late July.
