Meeting Minutes/Legal Action Report

1. Call to Order/Roll Call

2. Approval of LAR/Minutes - August 4, 2022

5. Reviews

a. 261-67 N Main

Reconstruction of existing porch.

The project was presented by Greg Clark, the property owner. The project proposes to construct new porch supports. The extant porch is pulling away from the house. The new supports would be 6"x6" wood posts with steel supports along the wall making the porch free-standing. There are other examples of 6"x6"

wood posts in the neighborhood and the inventory form notes that house has simple slender posts.

Board members had several questions about the project.

- Where would the steel posts be located?
 - We anticipate mid-span and at each end. It has not yet been designed.
- Have you considered encasing the steel posts with wood?
 - That could be possible.
- Cladding the steel posts in wood is possible. Could add corbels, but they should be simple in design.
- The steel supports along the wall could be painted to help them blend in.
- Are you repairing the plaster?
 - Yes, there are some areas of spot repair.
- Will the front wall need to be removed and replaced?
 - Yes, with large footings.

Generally, the project was supported. It was suggested that the structural plans for the supports was designed to better understand their placement.

6. Tucson Pima County Historical Commission Separation Update

Staff provided an update on the Tucson Pima County Historical Commission separation.

7. Staff Updates—Information Only

Staff provided an update on the permitting system and let board members know that training for TDC Online was available. TDC Online is the new method for submitting plans for permitting. Training times/dates are available on the city's website.
