Social Environment





Guiding Principles

Everyone is Welcome

Every view, voice, and experience of our community is integral to the conversation and will be welcomed with respect

Center Equity

Purposefully and respectfully seek, value, and uplift the voices of communities that have been underrepresented in planning and other governmental processes

Build Up and Collaborate

Affirm, integrate, and synthesize existing plans for continuity, incorporation of new priorities, and reduced duplication

Foster Authentic Participation

Incorporate community members' investment of time and energy using a variety of resources to support differing capacities for participation

Prioritize Safety and Accessibility for Participants

The Planning Team will monitor public health guidance, ensure language and physical accessibility, and utilize a range of locations and times for engagement opportunities

Community priorities; Organization of recent plans into the Update Preliminary draft of the Update that supports community priorities

Update approved by Planning Commission and Mayor and Council

Awareness of General Plan purpose and voter ratification of the Update


