## What's Plan Tucson?

Plan Tucson is the City of Tucson's general plan, a growth plan that will reflect our community's common goals and diverse aspirations for the next 20 years. Over the next two years, all Tucsonans are being asked to share input to help develop the new plan, starting with a series of community engagement activities as part of Phase 1, which is expected to run through June 2023.

This is your chance to learn about the City's recent efforts, assess our challenges and needs, and guide Tucson's long-term direction. See the flip side for the "Community Engagement" opportunities available for you and all City residents.

## What's in your plan, Tucson?

- Plan Tucson will include policies that are still relevant and identified in the prior plan and other City planning efforts, but it will also address new priorities and emerging issues that you help identify.
- The goals and policies identified in the new Plan Tucson will be used to guide the City's investments, programs, policies and land-use decisions over the next two decades.
- Once the Plan Tucson draft is reviewed by the public and accepted by the Mayor and City Council, it will be put on the ballot for voter approval in November 2025.
