

Fox takes control of underconstruction property (1929)
Opened April 11, 1930 (501st in chain)


Defining Characteristics

 Largest theatre in Southern Arizona at 1,300 seats/ 30,000 sq. ft. when built
Only example of Southwestern Art Deco decór
Unique acoustic material




Timeline – Built 1930

We hereby submit specifications and estimates for:

Provide all labor and equipment to demolish and remove the Fox Theater buildin slabs and floors. Remove footings where possible. Basement walls and footin adjacent building and sidewalks will be left in place to prevent damage. Bas will be broken down approximately one foot below grade. Remove the cantaleve ion booth and roof area over the buildings to the east. Dispose of all debris dump site. Walkways behind these buildings may have to be closed off and prote over the roof areas prior to cantalevered sections being removed. Retail s Congress will remain in place as well as stores along Stone, including baseme will be through the original entrance to the theater, off Congress.

Backfill the basements, main theater area and voids created by demolition to mat grades. Work with owner to secure demolition permit. Contractor to have salv bump fees and taxes included. Provide the air quality permit for our work.

EXCLUDE: Removal, relocation or capping of any utilities that feed this facily on to feed other facilities or that pass through this facility to other faciliti of transformers set for this property only. Testing, removal and disposal of any toxic, PCB containing or contaminated materials. Removal of any common walls. of walls adjacent to building being removed. Shoring, bracing and underpinning. of buildings adjacent to demolition. Temporary or permanent weather protection that are to remain. Preliminary studies required for demolition permit appli work in existing retail stores along Congress or Stone avenue.

BASE BID \$ 246,000.00




