Open Burning and Portable Outdoor Fireplaces Guidelines

A person shall not kindle or maintain or authorize to be kindled or maintained any *open burning* unless conducted and *approved* in accordance with the following:

***Open-flame cooking devices.** Charcoal burners and other open-flame cooking devices (i.e., BBQ's) shall not be operated on combustible balconies or within **10 feet** of combustible construction not protected by an automatic sprinkler system.

***Portable outdoor fireplaces.** Portable outdoor fireplaces shall be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and shall not be operated within **15 feet** of a structure or combustible material.

*Bonfires. A bonfire shall not be conducted within Tucson Fire's jurisdiction

*Recreational Fires. An outdoor fire burning materials other than rubbish where the fuel being burned is not contained in an incinerator, outdoor fireplace, portable outdoor fireplace, barbeque grill or barbeque pit and has a total fuel area of 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking, warmth, or similar purposes. The burning of dead or cut vegetation, waste material, or rubbish is prohibited.

- Recreational fires shall not be conducted within **25 feet** of a structure or combustible material. Conditions that could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
- Extinguishment authority. Where open burning creates or adds to a hazardous condition, the fire code official is authorized to order the extinguishment of the open burning operation.
- Attendance. Open burning, recreational fires, and portable outdoor fireplaces shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. Not fewer than one portable fire extinguisher complying with Section 906 with a minimum 4-A rating or other approved on-site fire-extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose or water truck, shall be available for immediate utilization.

*Sky lanterns. A person shall not release or cause to be released an untethered sky lantern.
