

BEER/WINE PERMIT HOLDER GUIDELINES

- 1. Applicant will be responsible for assuring any members of his/her party that are drinking beer or wine are of legal age to drink according to Arizona state law.
- 2. Permit is not transferable. If lost or stolen, permit is not refundable.
- 3. Permit valid for date and location identified only. Not valid for entire park.
- 4. Applicants must retain permit and permit must be made available upon request from proper park or police official.
- 5. This permit is not an authorization to sell beer or wine. The sale of alcoholic beverages in city parks is strictly prohibited without a special event liquor license issued by the State of Arizona.
- 6. No glass containers. TCC 21-3 (3)(3)
- 7. Per Tucson City Code #21-8, it is unlawful for any person to consume or have in their possession any spirituous liquor in a public park.
- 8. By obtaining this permit, the permit holder understands that the drinking age is 21 and anyone found in violation may be subject to a criminal charge according to Arizona state law.
